ComMUSICation (CMC) is seeking a Teaching Artist to teach Crescendo Choir for youth grades 3-5 at one or two sites in Saint Paul. The Teaching Artist (TA) works in collaboration with the Music and Program Director (MPD) to develop lessons and support the development of CMC youth.

## **Crescendo Choir Overview**

This is a beginner choir which will explore diverse genres and styles of music. CMC programs are based on youth-development practices and high-quality music education, and centered on community and cultural relevance.

### Responsibilities

Teach weekly Crescendo Choir with youth grades 3-5 at one or both sites:

Mondays and Wednesdays 2:15-3:15pm at Bruce Vento Elementary School Tuesdays and Thursdays 2:15-3:15pm Maxfield Elementary School

Collaborate with MD to create lesson plans that incorporate youth voice and choice into each class

Utilize music as a tool for community exploration, learning about history, and seeing its power to bring about social change

Work with on-site after school staff to manage youth behavior

Manage and report attendance to MPD

Check-in with MPD weekly and with other CMC staff as needed

Showcase program for families and community through performances, informances (informal, educational performances) TBD in collaboration with CMC staff
